HOPE Camp offers students 4 days of hands-on-activities and classes to explore a wide variety of health professions and health career opportunities while becoming familiar with the hospital and college campus settings. Most students attending the camp are considering college to become a health professional.

The camp is open for rural students entering 11th- 12th** grades in fall 2018. (**Students who are just graduating are also considered.)

Applications will be accepted from April 2-20.

HOPE Camp provides students the opportunity to:

- Explore a variety of health careers through interactive workshops
- Learn from health professionals and college instructors/students
- Identify the skills needed for careers in health care
- Experience dorm living and campus life

Dates:	June 17 - June 21 (check in 7-8:30pm 6/17 check out 10-11am 6/21)
Cost:	\$150 per student *
Transportation:	Student is responsible for own transportation to and from camp. While at camp transportation will be provided.
Supplies:	Students need to bring toiletry items, any personal items needed, water bottle, medication etc. (bedding and towel, washcloth provided)
Included:	Room (dorm room based on double occupancy), meals, chaperones, fees for camp supplies and recreation activities. Each student will receive a t-shirt to wear while participating.
