Youth Medical Explorers Program (YME) is a health career exploration program for high school students. Sessions are hosted at Sanford facilities in Sioux Falls and include a variety of presentations, tours, and hands-on activities.

As a Youth Medical Explorers member, students can also join the Future Health Professionals (HOSA) Sanford chapter and participate in HOSA activities, conferences, and scholarships. HOSA is an international student organization recognized by the U.S. Department of Education and the Health Science Education (HSE) Division of ACTE.

Summer Program 2019: June 10, 11, 12

A condensed version of the academic year is offered each summer. Students will meet with health care professionals and tour the hospital in three consecutive afternoons.

Academic Year Program: 2019-2020

Students attend monthly, after-hours informational sessions through the academic year. By the end of the program, students will have heard from a variety of health care professionals and students pursuing careers in health care, toured clinical departments, and participated in hands on activities. Typically held on Thursdays from 6:30 – 8:00 PM, September – April.
